

MANGA ART SHOW SUBMISSION FORM

Quad-Cities Libraries and the Figge Art Museum are organizing the first annual Teen Anime Fest and Manga Art Show. Young artists, ages 12-18, are invited to submit their original artwork drawn in manga or comic book style. All different mediums -paint, pencil, graphic design, etc.- can be used.

Artists should submit the artwork and entry form to their local library. Submissions will be accepted **September 2nd -October 3rd, 2008**. Depending on the number of entries, we may choose to display only one of each person's works

Artwork will be displayed at the Figge Art Museum on October 18th from 12-4:30pm in their studios. During this time, a drawing class will be held, refreshments will be served, and materials will be available for designing cosplay. Works will be judged and prizes will be awarded after a showing of *Spirited Away* in the auditorium.
