1. 5x7" b/w new print no photographer
Based on research, believe original was taken about 1870.
No connection established yet between Vogt and Frye families

Labeled on back as: Herman and Louisa FRYE and family of Davenport
Frank, George, Will Charles, Elizabeth, Baby, Julia

2. 4.5x7.5 sepia original image on cardboard no photographer
Labeled on back: H. H. V. place of business
412 Brady St. Davenport, Iowa
?__? To right of H. H. Vogt, Mr. Thompson, Derby, Dr. Blancke; others
unknown

Exterior of storefront at 412 Brady Street
Davenport Fish & Oyster Market run by Henry H. Vogt
*Note the large fish on the pole
Can also see storefront @ 410 "Al Billon, Jeweler and Engraver"
And @ 414 "Louis Boy Parlor Goods"

Based on research in city directories, I believe this image was taken between 1893-1895.

3. Notation re: advertisement in *Davenport Times* Oct. 31, 1898
H. H. Vogt
For fresh fish of all kinds
Prices as low as 6 cents and upwards
412 Brady Street
4. 6 x 8" sepia original image on cardboard
"Fowler View Co. 325 and 327 West Second Street, Davenport, Iowa" stamped in red in
center of back (appear in 1896-97 city directory)

Exterior of residence-Notation on back says "house on Perry Street", then that is crossed
out and it says "228 Harrison ca.1892"
Other notations: "Mrs. A. M. Vogt" (Mrs. Anna Marie Vogt)
H. H. Vogt (Henry H. Vogt)
Hired girl
George, Anna Marie, Harry (wife and 2 sons of Henry H. Vogt)
Hired man

Based on the photographer, I would say this was taken in 1896-97 and is most likely a residence
at 811 Perry Street in Davenport as that was the address of the Vogt family at that time.
(Fritz Wernentin was residing at 228 Harrison in 1896-97.)
