Unknown-	January 21, 1931	Sepia	11 x 13.5"	Class picture with Varna Glendine Hass identified. Signatures of classmates on the back. Group is posed outdoors in front of a building-probably the junior high Varna attended. Art deco design in matte
Eckerman Davenport, IA	June 1933	Sepia	12 x 13.5"	Class picture with Lavern Hass identified; Signatures of classmates on back. Group is posed outdoors in front of a building, probably the junior high Lavern attended. Art deco design in matte
Unknown	1939	B&w	5 x 8"	"Scavenger Hunt – Junior Class 1939-1940; ELH – 3 <sup>rd</sup> from left; JLD by smoking sign" written on back by donor. Large group of young men posed with items evidently obtained for scavenger hunt. Many are draped in toilet paper. Fits time period to be taken at Chicago school attended by E. L. Hass.

Woman has dark hair and eyebrows, is wearing drop earrings and several rings on her hand. Image is creased in the center horizontally. Identification on back: "N. Cruise – with love. The nurse that can make goodies to eat. From Donita."

Unknown	Ca1913	Sepia	8 x 10"	Halloween group of ten young women dressed in costumes and posed with a real skeleton. Identification: "4 <sup>th</sup> to left is Nathalia Cruise Hass". Image has some clear tape on verso. Very thin paper. Poor condition.
