William Henry "Harry" ROGERS – father

Rosina/Rosa/Rozina MEZGER ROGERS – mother

Married in Clark Co. Ohio Dec. 16, 1891

Hazel E. ROGERS born c 1892 – dau

Myrtle Grace ROGERS born 13 Aug 1894 Springfield, Clark Co. Ohio

Carl Edwin ROGERS born 3 Mar or Oct 1896 and died before 1910 census; donor says meningitis

Mildred ROGERS born 18 June 1898

The 1910 census in Ohio lists Rosa as head of house, widowed. All other census records say Widowed. Her death record [transcript only] says divorced. No finding for 1900 census to determine marital status or death of Carl.
