Yearly entries for 1962-1971 but noted as “Compiled by Mrs. DeEtta Mehl, Historian, 1970-1971”

Opens with:

“The “Staff Doctors’ Wives Auxiliary” as it was first known, was organized October 1, 1957, with the first actual meeting held October 23, 1957, at the home of Mrs. Norma Willard [Ralph]. First Bylaws were written and accepted June 1958 and notification of affiliation with A.A.O.A., was received September 1959.”

1958 original bylaws state the name of this organization shall be the:

Staff Doctors Wives Auxiliary to the Davenport Osteopathic Hospital

1971 new bylaws state the name of this organization shall be:

Auxiliary to the First District of the Iowa Society of Osteopathic Physicians and Surgeons—Unit 1.
